

Safe Schools and Violence Prevention

The program will address teaching the staff how to remain calm and confident during a crisis, prevent arguments from turning into fights, communicate behavior expectations to students, and develop and utilize a crisis intervention plan.

Administrators are taught to look at their school site through critical eyes -- regarding safety and order. This program addresses the issue of violence in our schools and provides some practical techniques to prevent violence.
