

Coaching, Monitoring & Follow-up Consulting

Consulting and monitoring days ensure the Effective Behavior Management Program is implemented completely and correctly. This time is critical for the program to have a thorough and lasting effect.

Coaching provides consistency, paying attention, insistence, monitoring, clarifying, assisting, refocusing, applauding, parent conference role modeling and encouragement.

The components of the program include:

The following is a list of activities that can be part of a coaching/consulting day. However, it is critical that the specific format and activities be developed in conjunction with each individual school's administration and program management committee.

- Coach teachers individually
- Visit and observe in classrooms
- Meet with new teachers as a group
- Observe the staff conducting parent conferences
- Meet with administrators
- Meet with support personnel
- Meet with Safety/Discipline
- Meet with staff during prep times in small groups
- Meet with teachers and staff during lunch and before school
- Conduct staff meeting or workshop during shortened day

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
